To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limiting or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every such corporation shall have

(a)...to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of

- (b) to sulf and be sued in its corporate name,
- (c) to have and/use a common seal and after the same at pleasure.
- (d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define their duties,
- (e) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or acticles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and deconducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of officers and directors, and containing any other provisions. whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs,
 - (f) to make contracts, incur liabilities and borrow money

Said corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000), provided, however, that the foregoing limitation shall not apply to certain corporations organized for the purposes enumerated in § 7-6-8. If any corporation subject to the foregoing limitation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) either originally or by amendment. such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto
