ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

Know all men by these Presents, That we, ANNIE B. TILLINGHAST, MARY E. GARDNER, SOPHIE SEARS, LOUISE DIMAN, GRACE H. BLANCHARD, ELLEN de FOREST THURSTON GLADDING, MAYBELLE P.D. FOSTER, JEANNIE C. ARNOLD, ~~M.B.~~, LAURA CHAPIN FREEMAN, MARY M. PRESTON and ESTHER C. TILLINGHAST, *Isabel G. Everett, Lorenzo Sears, Guy F. Smucker, William Ely*, all of the City and County of Providence and State of Rhode Island, all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1909.
