EXHIBIT A

The Corporation shall exist as a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Rhode Island.

The Corporation shall provide for the administration, operation, management, maintenance, preservation, and control of the BLACKBEARD HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, in the Town of South Kingstown, County of Washington, State of Rhode Island.

The Corporation shall exercise all powers and rights to negotiate for and acquire land on behalf of the member homeowners and to obtain the Right of First Refusal under Rhode Island General Law 34-18.2-3 for the leased land located at 836 Matunuck Beach Road designated as Tax Assessor's Plat 92-2, Lot 54.

The statement of corporate powers and purposes shall be broadly construed to effectuate the corporate purposes.

The Association does not contemplate pecuniary gain or benefit, direct or indirect, to its members. In way of explanation and not of limitations, the purpose for which it is formed are:

a) to provide for an entity for the furtherance of the interests of the owners of Residential Structures.

In furtherance, which unless indicated otherwise by the By-Laws, may be exercised by the Board of Directors:

- (a) all of the powers conferred upon non-profit corporations by common law and the statutes of the State of Rhode Island in effect from time to time;
- (b) all of the powers necessary or desirable to perform the obligations and duties and to exercise the rights and powers set out in the Articles of Incorporation.
- (c) the foregoing enumeration of powers shall not limit or restrict in any manner the exercise of other and further rights and powers which may now or hereafter be allowed or permitted by law; and the powers specified in each of the paragraphs of this Article are independent powers, not to be restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other paragraph or provision of this Article.
- (d) to do all things necessary and proper to accomplish the foregoing purposes.
