The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors, both elected and appointed, which shall exercise all of the powers of the Corporation, as specified in the by laws of the corporation.

The Board of Directors shall consist of members of the community and an elected Executive Board including a chairman, vice chair, secretary, and treasurer.

Upon dissolution of the Corporation any surplus remaining in the Corporation after payment of the dissolution expenses, and Corporation debts, shall be distributed to the R.I. Coalition for the Homeless to support their cause to end homelessness in the State of R.I.
