all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other :

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of Polish Citizens Club, Independent,

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of Literary and Social Advancement

4th. Said corporation shall be located in Providence R.I.
