It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The time within which the Spring Vale Cemetery Company of East
2 Providence, R.I., incorporated January 1, 1888 shall file the reports for the years 92, 93, 94, 95,
3 96, 97, 98, 99 as required under the provisions of section 7-6-90 of the general laws of Rhode
4 Island, 1956, is hereby extended to the 31st day of December, A.D., 1990. If said corporation
5 shall file in the office of the secretary of state before December 31, 1999, the reports which it
6 should have filed in the said years and shall pay to the secretary of state the filing fees therefor,
7 having previously thereto paid to the general treasurer for the use of the state such sum as the
8 attorney general shall decide should be paid by said corporation as a compromise for the penalty
9 or penalties for its failure to file such reports, then the forfeiture or revocation of the charter of
10 said corporation shall thereupon, to wit, upon the filing of said reports and the payment of said
11 fees, be vacated and said corporation shall thereupon be entitled to all of the privileges, benefits
12 and powers and subject to the same duties and liabilities as though no forfeiture or revocation of
13 its said charter had taken place.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
