ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR DAK PROPERTIES, INC.

Article FIFTH of the Articles of Incorporation for DAK PROPERTIES, INC. shall read as follows:

No shareholder of the corporation shall make sale of any of the stock of the corporation held by them without first giving notice to the corporation of her intention to sell the same and giving the corporation the right to purchase said stock at the lowest price at which they are willing to sell before the same may be sold by them to any other party. The corporation shall exercise the right to purchase the stock as offered it within thirty (30) days from the date of the receipt of said offer, and if not accepted within said time, the shareholder shall be at liberty to make sale of the stock so offered to the corporation in the open market for not less than the price named by them. By unanimous consent of all the shareholders present at any meeting, the holder of stock, may be authorized and permitted to transfer the same to any other person or persons, and such authorization shall be considered a waiver by the corporation of its right to have the stock offered to it first before the offering of the same for sale to any other party.
