and held in the auditorium of Providence YWCA
in said State, on the seventh day of November, A. D. 1946,
the following amendment (s) to the Articles of Association was (or were) duly adopted by
the affirmative vote of 39 of its members, viz:—

"VOTED, That

the name of this Corporation shall be The League of
Women Voters of Rhode Island. This State League is
an integral part of The League of Women Voters of
the United States. The purpose of The League of
Women Voters of Rhode Island shall be to promote
political responsibility through informed and
active participation of citizens in government.
