Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-6-40 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

- 1. The name of the corporation is Hands United In Christ Foundation
2. The following amendment to the Articles of incorporation was adopted by the corporation.

First: The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation shall located is the city of City of Providence, New England County.

Second: The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes Consist of Take care of the Orphans & ,Needy children and Elderly. Including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section501(c)(3) of the internal code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

Third: The aggregate number of authorize Board of Directors are: 7

Fourth: Provision for regulating the internal affairs of the corporation are:

1. Fiscal Year. The fiscal year of the Foundation shall be fixed by resolution of the Board of Directors

2. Seal The Foundation seal shall have inscribed thereon the Foundation and year of its incorporation under the laws of the State of Rhode Island. This seal may be used by causing it or a facsimile thereof to be impressed or affixed or in any manner reproduced.

3. Examination of Books and Records. Each member, or their representatives shall be entitled to a reasonable examination of the books and records of the Foundation at any time upon a reasonable notice to its Board of Directors. The declaration Certificate of Incorporation and the By-Laws of the Foundation shall be available for inspection by any member at the principal office of the Foundation.

Fifth: The address of initial registered office of the corporation is #5 Olneyville Square Providence, Rhode Island 02909.

**Eighth:** No director, officer, employee, or other person connected with the Corporation, or any private individual, shall receive at any time any of the net earnings or pecuniary profit from the operation of the Foundation, provided, however, that this provision shall not prevent payment to any such person of duly authorized expenses as approved by the Board of Directors. These expenses may only include the return of money advanced by the person concerned or salaries of employees hired at the direction of the Board of Directors or fees to professionals engaged at the direction of the Board. In the event of dissolution, all assets, after satisfaction of debts shall be disposed of by the Board of Directors as required by the Articles of Incorporation of the Foundation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda ,or otherwise attempting to influence legislation ,and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles ,this corporation shall not , except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

**Ninth:** No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members ,trustees ,officers ,or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article second hereof.

**Tenth :** Upon dissolution of this Corporation assets shall be distributed to corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or for purposes set forth in article second hereof.

**Eleventh:** Members of this Foundation are not, personally liable for the debts, liabilities or obligations of the Foundation.

**Twelve :** (a) Membership class shall be determined by the following categories

- .Orphans & Needy -- Children age 5 - 15.
- . Senior - Persons over the age of 60.
- .Sponsors - - Regular Persons or organization: Churches, Business Industrial-Commercial-Corporate, Christians Community, Foundation.

Applicants shall be admitted to membership upon completion of a standard membership form and tender of first year's dues.

The Foundation shall have the right to periodically fix membership fee.

(a) Each class of membership may be assessed a different annual dues or arrangements.

(b) No fee shall be charged for making application for membership in the organization.

(c) Memberships shall be non-assessable .
