## ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-1.1 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

First. The name of the corporation is Durkee & Brown Architects, Inc.

(A close corporation pursuant to §7-2.1-51 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended) (strike if mapplicable)

Second. The period of its duration is (if perpetual, so state) Perpetual

THIRD. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To conduct, operate, perform and carry out general architectural design services, interior space planning and design, construction estimating and feasibility studies, site analysis and planning, furniture and display design and urban planning; to provide management and/or consulting services related to the above; to conduct any and all activities deemed necessary, desirable and/or ancillary in connection with any or all of the above-described matters; to transact such other lawful business as shall be permissible under the Rhode Island business corporation act, as the same may be amended from time to time.

FIFTH. Provisions (if any) dealing with the preemptive right of shareholders pursuant to \$7-1.1-24 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended:

The shareholders of the corporation shall be entitled to a preemptive right, for a period of thirty (30) days, to subscribe for, purchase, or otherwise acquire in the proportions which their holdings of the shares of the common stock of the corporation bear to the outstanding common stock, any shares of the same class of the corporation or any equity and/or voting shares of any class of the corporation which the corporation proposes to issue, or any rights or options which the corporation proposes to grant for the purchase of shares of the same class of the corporation or of equity and/or voting shares of any class of the corporation or for the purchase of any shares, bonds, securities, or obligations of the corporation which are convertible into or exchangeable for, or which carry any rights, to subscribe for, purchase, or otherwise acquire shares of the same class of the corporation or equity and/or voting shares of any class of the corporation, whether now or hereafter authorized or created, whether having unissued or treasury status, and whether the proposed issue, reissue, transfer, or grant is for cash, property, or any other lawful consideration. The preemptive rights granted herein shall be deemed waived by any shareholder who does not so exercise them and pay for the shares, rights, options, bonds, securities or obligations within said thirty (30) days of receipt of notice in writing from the corporation stating the prices, terms and conditions of the offering. After the expiration of said thirty (30) days, any and all of such shares, rights, options, bonds, securities or obligations of the corporation may be issued, reissued, transferred, or granted by the corporation, as the case may be, to such persons, firms, corporations and associations, and for such lawful consideration, and on such terms as the corporation in its discretion may determine. As used herein, the terms "equity shares" and "voting shares" shall mean, respectively, shares wich confer unlimited dividend rights and shares which confer unlimited voting rights.

Sixth. Provisions (if any) for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation:

The corporation may, from time to time, and in conformity with the provisions of the Rhode Island Business Corporation Act, distribute to its shareholders, directly or by the purchase of its own shares, a portion of its assets, in cash or property out of the unreserved and unrestricted capital surplus of the corporation.
