## ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION (NON-BUSINESS CORPORATION)

Know all Men by these Bresents. That we Anthony De Angelis,
Stephen Brunero, Robert Hagan, Ermin Paliotta and
Guy Viti
all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:
FIRST. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation
under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws of
Rhode Island, as amended.
SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of
Sacred Heart Housing Corporation
THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of the planning,
constructing, erecting, maintaining, operating and managing land, .
buildings and improvements for the purpose of providing housing and
related facilities and services for the elderly. To provide on a
nonprofit basis, housing for lower income families and families
displaced from urban renewal areas, or as a result of a major disaster,
where no adequate housing exists for such groups, pursuant to Section
236 of the National Housing Act, as amended. Such Housing may include facilities for the elderly and handicapped.
The Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to and operated exclusivel
for, nonprofit purposes; and no part of the income or assets shall be
distributed to, nor inure to the benefit of any individual.
In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and
authority, viz:—(See §§ 7-6-7. 7-6-8 of the General Laws.)
To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limiting or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every such corporation shall have power:
(a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter;
(b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name; (c) to have and use a common seal and alter the same at pleasure;
(d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define their duties;
(e) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or articles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, and containing any other provisions, whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs;
(f) to make contracts, incur liabilities and horrow money.  Said corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one bundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000); provided, however, that the foregoing limitation shall not apply to corporations organized for the purposes of fostering, encouraging and assisting the physical location, settlement or resettlement of industrial and manufacturing enterprises within the state, and to whose members no profit shall enure. If any corporation subject to the foregoing limitation deliver to take and hold presents are account members on profit shall enure. If any corporation subject to the foregoing
limitation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto

FIFTH The Corporation is empowered:	
(a) To buy, own, sell, convey, assign, m	ortgage or lease any interest
in real estate and personal property and to	construct, maintain and operate

purposes of the Corporation, including the e	execution of a Regulatory

and undertakings as may be necessary to enat	ole the Corporation to secure th
benefits of financing with the assistance of	mortgage insurance under the

property shall not be conveyed to any organi	ization created or operated for

The directors shall elect the regular officers of the Corporation at the annual meeting, for terms of one year. The secretary and treasurer may be one and the same person, and not be a director of the Corporation. Other officers must be directors of the Corporation.

The annual meeting shall be held on the First Monday in March of each year. SEVENTH By laws of the Corporation may be adopted by the directors at any regular meeting or any special meeting called for that purpose, so long as they are not inconsistent with the provisions of these Articles or of the Regulatory Agreement between the Corporation and the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, pursuant to Article II hereof.

EIGHTH So long as a mortgage on the Corporation's property is insured or held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, these Articles may not be amended without the prior written approval of the said Secretary
