ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-1.1 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST. The name of the corporation is LONSDALE CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION, INC.

(A close corporation pursuant to §7-1.1-31 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended) (strike if inapplicable)

SECOND. The period of its duration is (if perpetual, so state) Perpetual

THIRD. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To conduct and carry on the business of builders and contractors for the purpose of building, erecting, altering, repairing or doing any other work in connection with any and all classes of building and improvements in the form of cement flooring and generally to do and perform any and all works as builders and contractors in respect of that business and to transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Rhode Island Business Corporations Act, and to have all the powers conferred upon corporations organized under the Rhode Island Business Corporations Act.

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FOURTH. The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is:


