REINSTATING AND RESTORING FORFEITED  
OR REVOKED CORPORATE CHARTERS

96.H 9294

Introduced By: Rep. Leona Kelley

Date Introduced: July 10, 1996

Referred To: Committee on Corporations

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1           SECTION 1. The revocation of the charters of those business cor-  
2 porations enumerated in section 3 hereof, which are required by law to  
3 file annual reports with the secretary of state, shall be vacated.  
4 Said corporations shall be entitled to all the privileges, benefits,  
5 and powers, and shall be subject to all of the same duties and liabil-  
6 ities as though no revocation of their charters had taken place if, on  
7 or before December 31, 1996, said corporations shall (1) file any cor-  
8 poration tax returns as may be required; (2) pay all taxes which were  
9 due or should have been due to the state; (3) file with the secretary  
10 of state a certificate signed by the tax administrator that such tax  
11 returns have been filed and such taxes have been paid; and (4) also  
12 file all reports and pay all fees which may be required by the secre-  
13 tary of state.

14           SECTION 2. The forfeiture or revocation of the charters of those  
15 nonprofit corporations enumerated in section 3 hereof, which are re-

1    quired by law to file biennial and/or annual reports with the secre-  
2    tary of state, shall be vacated. Said corporations, subject to chapter  
3    7-6, as amended, of the general laws, entitled the "Rhode Island non-  
4    profit corporation act" notwithstanding any provision of the law to  
5    the contrary, shall file all reports and pay all fees which may be re-  
6    quired by the secretary of state, and shall also pay to the general  
7    treasurer for the use of the state such sum as the attorney general  
8    shall decide should be paid by said corporations, as a compromise of  
9    the penalty or penalties for such failure to file such reports.

10       SECTION 3. The provisions of this act shall apply to the follow-  
11    ing corporations:

15       SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
