ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-6 of the General laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of incorporation:

1. The name of the corporation is American Firefighters Motorcycle Club - Rhode Island Chapter, Inc.
2. The period of its duration is (if perpetual, so state) Perpetual
3. The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
To raise money and provide support for the Rhode Island Special Olympics and such other charitable organizations as the corporation may from time to time decide; to promote brotherhood of both active and retired firefighters; and to conduct any and all lawful business for which charitable organizations may operate under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) and non-profit corporations may be organized under the Rhode Island Non-Profit Corporation Act.
4. Provisions, if any, not inconsistent with the law, which the incorporators elect to set forth in these articles or incorporation for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are:
 - a. The Corporation shall have such classes of members as the Board of Directors may, from time to time, provide in the by-laws. However, any and all classes of members so designated by the Board of Directors shall be non-voting, and members shall not participate in the management of the affairs of the Corporation.
 - b. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.
 - c. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a State or Local Government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.
