Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-6-40 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Pawtucket Soup Kitchen

SECOND: The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the organization is organized exclusively for one or more of the irposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and shall not carry on any activities not muitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under IRC 501(c)(3) or corresponding provisions any subsequent tax laws.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer of e organization, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for e organization), and no member, trustee, officer of the organization or any private individual shall be entitled to share the distribution of any of the organization's assets on dissolution of the organization.

No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to fluence legislation (except as otherwise provided by IRC 501(h) or participating in, or intervening in (including the blication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidates for blic office.

In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the organization shall after payment of necessary penses thereof be distributed to such organizations as shall qualify under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws, or to the Federal government or State or local vernment for a public purpose, subject to the approval of a Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Rhode Island. In any taxable year in which the organization is a private foundation as described in IRC 509(a), the organization shall stribute its income for said period at such time and manner as not to subject it to tax under IRC 4942, and the organization shall not (a) engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in IRC 4941(d), (b) retain any excess business holdings
