The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

Said corporation is organized and operated exclusively for historical, charitable, patriotic, scientific, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the receipt and acceptance of contributions which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The perpetuation of the spirit, prestige, and memories of the military of Rhode Island. To foster and encourage the study of Rhode Island military history. The acquisition, collection, interpretation, storage, conservation,

FOURTH: Provisions (if any) for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including provisions for the distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation, are:

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

and exhibition of documents and artifacts relating to the history of the military of Rhode Island. The research, writing, and publication of manuscripts pertaining to Rhode Island military history. The education of the general public regarding the mission and functions of the military of Rhode Island. To aid in maintaining national honor, union, and independance. To strengthen the ties of fellowship and mutual assistance among members of the corporation. The preservation and proper maintenance of the Benefit Street Arsenal structure. Any lawful function in furhterance of these objectives.

### FOURTH (Continued)

In the event of dissolution of the corporation or in the event that it shall cease to exist for the stated purposes, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Majority Membership: The majority of the members of the Board of Directors of the corporation shall be charter members of the corporation.

Initial Board of Directors: The initial Board of Directors of the corporation shall be composed of fifteen members and shall be elected by a majority vote of the incorporators of the corporation. Election:

- a. Five Directors shall be elected to serve for a three year period or until their respective successor has been elected and qualified.
- b. Five Directors shall be elected to serve for a two year period or until their respective successor has been elected and qualified.
- c. Five Directors shall be elected to serve for a one year period or until their respective successor has been elected and qualified.

No amendment to the corporation constitution and bylaws shall be effective which shall prevent said corporation from being exempt from federal income taxation under the provisions of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or prevent said corporation from being an organization to which a contribution constitutes a "charitable contribution" as defined in Section 170 (c) (2) of said Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
