ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1909.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of The Rhode Island
Dental Society

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of Fraternal intercourse,
educational advancement and united action toward raising the standard
of the dental profession and securing the protection of the public.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in The City of Providence.
