ORDERED, ADJUGED AND DECREED:

1. Plaintiff may file, upon payment of the filing fee,  
its annual reports for the years 1983, 1984 and 1985 as attached  
to the Complaint and made a part thereof.

2. The Defendant shall accept for filing upon the payment  
of the filing fee said annual reports for the years 1983,  
1984 and 1985.

3. Upon the filing of said annual reports and the payment  
of the filing fee, the Defendant shall reinstate the Charter  
of the Plaintiff corporation and consider the same in good  
standing retroactive to the date of its forfeiture.

4. Plaintiff hereby waives any rights to a hearing  
de novo pursuant to R.I.G.L. 7-1.1-133.


