A N A C T

REINSTATING AND RESTORING FORFEITED
CORPORATE CHARTERS

Introduced By: Senator Smith

Date Introduced: February 15, 1985

Referred To: Senate Corporations

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The forfeiture of the charters of those corpora-
2 tions enumerated in section 3 hereof, which are required by law
3 to file annual reports with the secretary of state, shall be
4 vacated. Said corporations shall be entitled to all the privi-
5 leges, benefits, and powers, and shall be subject to all of the
6 same duties and liabilities as though no forfeiture of their
7 charters had taken place if, on or before December 31, 1985, said
8 corporations shall (1) file any corporation tax returns as may be
9 required; (2) pay all taxes which were due or should have been
10 due to the state; (3) file with the secretary of state a certifi-
11 cate signed by the tax administrator that such tax returns have
12 been filed and such taxes have been paid; and (4) also file all
13 reports and pay all fees which may be required by the secretary
14 of state.
- 15 SECTION 2. The forfeiture of the charters of those corpora-
16 tions enumerated in section 3 hereof, which are required by law
17 to file biennial reports with the secretary of state, shall be

1 vacated. Said corporations, subject to chapter 7-6, as amended,
2 of the general laws, entitled "Nonbusiness corporations", not-
3 withstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, shall file
4 all reports and pay all fees which may be required by the secre-
5 tary of state, and shall also pay to the general treasurer for
6 the use of the state such sum as the attorney general shall
7 decide should be paid by said corporations, as a compromise of
8 the penalty or penalties for such failure to file such reports.

9 SECTION 3. The provisions of this act shall apply to the
