2. Article Third and Article Fourth are amended as follows:

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are to receive, hold and invest contributed funds and to expend said funds for charitable, benevolent, philanthropic, educational, civic and youth activities.

FOURTH: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. The corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf or, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) or (4) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provisions of any future federal tax code as the Board of Directors shall determine.
