



Patrick J. Conole, John R. Ward,


all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of *Newport*

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of *promoting social*
intimacy among the members of the Association,
and for the charitable and benevolent purpose
of giving aid to needy and disabled active
members of said Association.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in *Newport R.I.*
