ATTACHMENT A

Purpose of Organization

- A) Weybosset Street Community Center is organized for the purpose of providing non-denominational, social welfare programming for the health, education, and well-being of the residents of the greater Providence area.
- B) The corporation is irrevocably dedicated to and operated exclusively for, non-profit purposes. No part of the income or assets of the corporation shall be distributed to, or inure to the benefit of any individual.
- C) This corporation is organized for charitable and/or educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or RIGL 44-18-30.
- D) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
