1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

DAVISVILLE FREE LIBRARY ASSOCIATION..

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of promoting the moral, intellectual, and social improvement of the inhabitants of Davisville and vicinity by the establishment of a free public library and other educational agencies.

4th. Said corporation shall be located in DAVISVILLE in the TOWN OF
NORTH KINGSTOWN, STATE OF RHODE ISLAND
