We, the undersigned officers of Providence Building, Sanitary and Educational Association, a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Rhode Island, hereby certify that the vote prescribed for the amendment of the by-laws of said corporation is "a vote of two thirds of the members present and voting"; and that at the annual meeting of said corporation, duly called and held in the City of Providence, in said State, on the 9th day of January, 1967, at which a quorum of the members was present, the following amendment to the charter of said corporation was duly adopted by the unanimous affirmative vote of the members of said corporation present at said meeting, viz.:

"VOTED: That the Charter of this corporation be amended by the addition of the following provision, viz.:

"Sec. 10. The said corporation shall have power to enter into a Regulatory Agreement with the Federal Housing Commissioner (or successor officer) and such other instruments and undertakings as may be necessary to enable the said corporation to secure the benefits of financing with the assistance of mortgage insurance under the provisions of the National Housing Act. Such Regulatory Agreement and other instruments and undertakings shall remain binding upon the said corporation, its successors and assigns, so long as a mortgage on the said corporation's property is insured or held by the Federal Housing Commissioner."
