

ORDER

This matter, having come before the Court for a WebEx hearing on January 7, 2021, on the Petition to Approve Settlement and Final Report, Recommendation on Claims, and Request for Approval of Fees, Costs, and Expenses of the Receiver, after consideration of the written and oral arguments of the Receiver, with no objection from any interested party, it is hereby:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED

1. All of the acts, doings, and disbursements of the Receiver are approved, confirmed and ratified;
2. The Receiver's Settlement Agreement with Carlos H. Silva and Silver Lining Restaurants, Inc. ("SLR"), is approved, the Receiver is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the settlement, and the Receiver is permitted to use the \$8,000.00 in settlement proceeds and the \$15,000.00 SLR Deposit in his possession to satisfy any and all outstanding administrative fees, costs and expenses;

3. The Receiver is awarded a final allowance for his services as Temporary and Permanent Receiver, to be paid from remaining cash-on-hand and any future funds that may be collected by the Receiver for the benefit of the Estate;
4. This Court accepts the Receiver's position that no Recommendation on Claims is necessary because the amount of the Receiver's approved fees, costs, and expenses exceed the total cash-on-hand and that once the Receiver's allowance is accounted for there will be no assets of the estate remaining to satisfy any claimants;
5. The Receiver's Bonds are ordered cancelled and the Receiver is discharged;
6. The Receiver is hereby authorized, in his discretion, to abandon or destroy all books and records of Respondents;
7. The Respondent corporations are hereby ordered dissolved and the Receiver is directed to forward a copy of this Order to the Office of the Secretary of State for the State of Rhode Island; and
8. This proceeding is closed.
