
That said acts are attached hereto and identified as follows:

1. 82-H7177. An act authorizing the Town of Narragansett to appropriate money for the use and benefit of the Bonnet Shores Fire District, in amendment of Chapter 68 of the Public Laws of 1964.
2. 82-H7175. An act relating to the Bonnet Shores Fire District in amendment of Section 5 of an act to incorporate the Bonnet Shores Fire District relative to fines in excess of \$50.00 and the enforcement thereof by the Fourth Division District Court of Washington County.
3. 82-H7178. An act relating to the Bonnet Shores Fire District in amendment of Section 7 providing for the purchase or construction of any buildings for recreational purposes and for recreational programs and activities for the benefit of the taxpayers for the Bonnet Shores Fire District.
4. 82-H7176 Sub. A. An act to empower the Town Council of the Town of Narragansett to exempt from assessment and taxation sewer installations in and to and adjacent to real property of the Bonnet Shores Fire District within the Town of Narragansett.

That all of the aforesaid acts were accepted by the affirmative vote of a majority of the voters of said Fire District at said Annual Meeting of the Fire District of June 24, 1982 at which meeting a quorum was present and that the notice of said meeting was properly constituted in accordance with the By-Laws of the Bonnet Shores Fire District and that said legislation aforesaid was presented to the voters present for their rejection or acceptance.

That the affirmative vote with respect to 82-H7177 and 82-H7175 was unanimous. That the affirmative vote of the voters relative to 82-H7178 and 82-7176 was a majority vote with one objection thereto to each act.

I hereby certify that I am the duly elected Clerk of the Bonnet Shores Fire District and that the aforesaid certificate is true and is provided to the Honorable Secretary of State by me pursuant to Section 9 of the act to incorporate the Bonnet Shores Fire District of January 1932.

OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1964

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1 and 2 of chapter 68 of the public laws of 1964,
2 entitled "An act authorizing the town of Narragansett to appro-
3 priate money for the use and benefit of the Bonnet Shores Fire
4 District" as amended by chapter 1908 of the public laws of 1947
5 is hereby amended to read as follows:

6 SECTION 1. The town of Narragansett is hereby authorized
7 and empowered to appropriate commencing in the year 1981 and
8 annually thereafter a grant as it shall deem necessary to be
9 expended for the use and benefit of the Bonnet Shores Fire Dis-
10 trict.

11 SECTION 2. The grant appropriated under the foregoing
12 provisions shall be expended in said fire district for public
13 purposes, such as water, lighting, fire protection, road mainte-
14 nance, and police as the district council of said fire district

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of the act to incorporate the Bonnet
2 Shores fire district, passed at the January session, A.D. 1932,
3 as amended is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 SECTION 5. The district may adopt such rules, regulations,
5 ordinances, and by-laws as may be reasonably necessary to enable
6 it to fulfill its corporate purposes and may provide a penalty
7 for the breach of such rules, regulations, ordinances or by-laws
8 which for each offense shall be a fine not exceeding fifty
9 dollars, one-half of the fine imposed to be for the use of the
10 district, or imprisonment for a term of not exceeding thirty
11 days, which penalties may be imposed, upon complaint of the dis-
12 trict or any of its officers, by the Fourth Division District
13 Court at Washington County. Rules, regulations, ordinances or by-
14 laws may also prescribe the powers and duties of officers and

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of the act to incorporate the Bonnet
2 Shores fire district, passed at the January session, A.D., 1932,
3 as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 Section 7. The district may raise money by taxation of real
5 estate, and buildings or improvements upon leased real estate
6 within the district, provided, that the tax assessed and payable
7 in any one (1) year under the provisions of this act shall not
8 exceed seven (7) mills on each dollar of valuation as hereinafter
9 defined. Taxation may be for any or all of the following pur-
10 poses:

11 The maintenance, upkeep and improvement of existing private
12 streets, walks and ways; the establishment and maintenance of ad-
13 ditional private streets, walks and ways; the regulation and
14 policing of the same in such manner as to assure the lawful use

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town council of the town of Narragansett
 2 shall/exempt the Bonnet Shores Fire District from/payment of
 3 sewer assessment taxes/ on real property owned by it within the
 4 town of Narragansett; provided, however, that such sewer assess-
 5 ments shall constitute a lien on such property, which lien shall
 6 become due and payable in the event of the conveyance of the
 7 property by the Bonnet Shores Fire District.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
