ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION
(NON-BUSINESS CORPORATION)

Know all Men by these Presents, That we *Bishop Charlie Barber,*
Evangelist Alice Cartagena Almedina, 1st Assistant
Evangelist Louisa F. Hamrick, 2nd Assistant
General Secretary and Missionary Grace M. Carter,
Head Deacon Elder Derrick Freeman, Deaconess Missionary Sarah Cart.
all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

FIRST. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, as amended.

SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

The Morning Star Full Gospel Church
Apostolic Faith, Missions Inc.

THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of *spreading the*
Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Circulation of the Bible
and Unity and fellowship among the Christian Churches.
Jesus chose his twelve Apostles, and gave them proper
training, and gave them Commandments Concerning the
"Kingdom of Heaven." He ye therefore, and teach
all Nations, baptizing them in the name of the
Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching
them to observe all things whatsoever I have Commanded
you, and lo! I am with you always, even unto the end of the world

In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and authority, viz:—(See §§ 7-6-7, 7-6-8 of the General Laws.)

To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limiting or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every such corporation shall have power:

- (a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter;
- (b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name;
- (c) to have and use a common seal and alter the same at pleasure;
- (d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define their duties;

(e) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or articles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, and containing any other provisions, whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs;

- (f) to make contracts, incur liabilities and borrow money.

Said corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000): provided, however, that the foregoing limitation shall not apply to corporations organized for the purposes of fostering, encouraging and assisting the physical location, settlement or resettlement of industrial and manufacturing enterprises within the state, and to whose members no profit shall ensue. If any corporation subject to the foregoing limitation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto

FOURTH. Said corporation shall be located in Providence, Rhode Island.

FIFTH. With scriptural proof, the Commandments of, The Gospel of Jesus Christ and his Apostles; The Apostolic Doctrine: St. Matt. 28: 19, 20; St. Mark 16: 15-20; St. Luke 24: 47, 48; Isaiah 9: 1-5; Matt. 1: 21; Acts 4: 12; Acts 2: 38-47; Acts 20: 18-38; Matt. 21: 42-44; Galatians 3: 20-29; St. John 17 ch.; St. John 20 ch.; St. John 1st ch. St. Luke 24: 44-53; St. Mark 16 ch. 15 chapter, Acts 11: 14-18; II Corinthians 4: 1-7; II Timothy 4 ch. 1-8 verse; Revelations 2: 25; Acts 1st ch. Revelations 19, 20, 21, 22nd Chapters.

In matters pertaining to order and methods of the Administration; The Church is to exercise its Liberty, so long, as it is, in obedience to the Apostolic Doctrine.

SIXTH. This Church will approve all teachings, Methods and Biblical Conduct with scripture proof; To establish Movements of Evangelism throughout the World. To practice the Apostolic Doctrine and Fellowship, Jesus Christ, being the founder, and Chief Cornerstone of the Church, Ephesians 2: 19, 20;

The President and Bishop of this incorporation, Bishop Charlie Barber, and the Executive Council and Finance Committee and Trustees. Being the incorporators of this Corporation shall hold their Offices throughout their lifetime, and as long as they live according to the doctrine.

SEVENTH. Executive Council - Finance Committee - Trustees" Evangelist Alice Cartagena Almeida - Vice President of Corporation. Evangelist Louise F. Hamrick - Ass. Vice President of Corporation. Missionary Grace M. Carter - General Secretary of Corporation. Missionary Sarah R. Clark - Treasurer of Corporation. Elder Derrick Lewis Freeman - Minister of Church Affairs. The five - persons named above is the Executive Council. The President and Executive body, and Members of the incorporations by majority votes in the Annual General Assembly; Business Meeting; have the power and Authority to make such changes as deemed necessary for the growth and prosperity of the Corporation; The President being head directed over all.

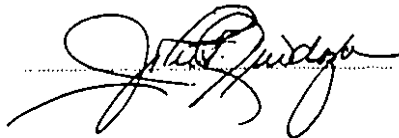
