Each limited partner shall receive on the last day of each month an amount computed at the lowest call loan rate (charged by New York City banks on brokers' loans secured by stock exchange collateral) in effect on such day or at the rate of 6 per cent (6%) per annum, whichever is greater, upon the amount of cash capital standing to his credit from time to time during said month.
- 2. Each limited partner shall in addition be credited annually with a percentage of the profits of the partnership which percentage shall be subject to change by the managing partners at any time.

5. Article XII is struck out and in place thereof the following is inserted:

XII. No limited partner shall have priority over any other limited partner as to contributions or as to compensation by way of income.

6. Article XIV is struck out and in place thereof the following is inserted:

XIV. No limited partner shall have any right or power whatsoever to demand and receive property other than cash in return for his contribution.

No limited partner has any right or power to conduct and control partnership affairs or in the name or behalf of the partnership to enter into any undertaking, agreement or obligation of any sort.
