R.I. Chapter No. 1, Women In Construction - Deborah Petterson

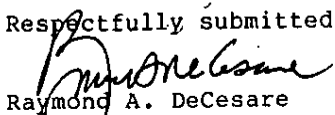
The Fund continues to investigate sources of financial support. Minimum income was derived in 1984. A copy of the Treasurer's Annual Report is available upon request.

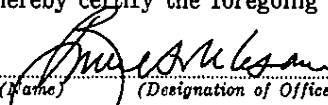

R.I. Chapter No. 1, Women In Construction - Lynn Potter

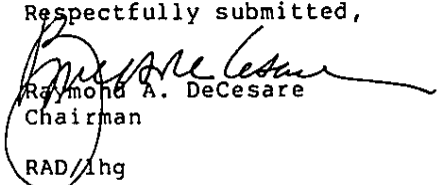
Only minimal contributions were received during 1982, the financial status of the Fund is quite healthy at this point. A copy of the Treasurer's Annual Report is attached.

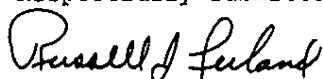
