

(1) To own and operate a general non-profit technical institute giving courses of study and instruction, by correspondence or otherwise, to such persons of both sexes as may desire it, in radio, television and other electronic fields, in air conditioning, refrigeration, heating and other mechanical fields, and in all other subjects of every type and description constituting a technical or scientific education.

(2) To manufacture, buy, sell, at wholesale or at retail, lease and deal in books, instruments, equipment and supplies of every type and description relating to the foregoing fields and subjects;

(3) To prepare for publication, bind, sell, lease or otherwise deal in pamphlets, magazines, newspapers and publications of every type and description relative to the foregoing fields and subjects;

(4) To lease, purchase or otherwise acquire real estate and personal property for the carrying out of any of the purposes of the corporation;

(5) To hire personnel for the operation of the corporation, including instructors and office help, and any other employees that may be necessary or desirable.

whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs;

(1) to make contracts, incur liabilities and borrow money.

Said corporation shall be entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000); provided, however, that the foregoing limitation shall not apply to corporations organized for the purposes of fostering, encouraging and assisting the physical location, settlement or resettlement of industrial and manufacturing enterprises within the state, and to whose members no profit shall ensue. If any corporation subject to the foregoing limitation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto

FOURTH. Said corporation shall be located in Providence, Rhode Island.  
(City or Town)

(Further provisions not inconsistent with law)

FIFTH. The members of said corporation shall be the Incorporators, the members of the Board of Trustees, the officers and persons elected to membership by the Incorporators at their first meeting, and those elected by two-thirds vote at any meeting of the members or of the Board of Trustees.

SIXTH. Said corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes, and no part of the net earnings of such corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of these Articles of Association, no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and said corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

SEVENTH. In the event of dissolution, winding up, or other liquidation of the assets of said corporation, whether voluntary, involuntary, or by operation of law, its assets shall be distributed after the payment of all liabilities to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees of said corporation shall determine.
