AN ACT

IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF COLONY OF RHODE ISLAND, AT ITS FEBRUARY SESSION A. D. 1741, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO CHARTER A MILITARY COMPANY BY THE NAME OF THE ARTILLERY COMPANY OF THE TOWN OF NEWBORT," AND OF THE SEVERAL ACTS IN AMENDMENT THEREOF

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. On the last Tuesday in the month of April A. D., 1935, the members of the Artillery Company of Newport, then in good standing and qualified according to the By-Laws thereof to participate in the election of its commissioned officers, in meeting duly assembled, shall, by a majority of such members present at such meeting, elect their officers who shall hold their commissions for a term of three years, said commissions to be in accordance with the Charter and of the several acts in amendment thereof.

SEC. 2. Thereafter on the last Tuesday in the month of April A. D. 1938 and every third year after, officers shall be likewise elected for a term of three years.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage, and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
