AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE COLONY OF RHODE ISLAND, AT ITS FEBRUARY SESSION, A. D. 1733, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO CHARTER A MILITARY COMPANY BY THE NAME OF THE ARTILLERY COMPANY OF THE TOWN OF NEWPORT," AND OF THE SEVERAL ACTS IN AMENDMENT THEREOF.

March 30, 1910.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1. The artillery company in Newport, in addition to the officers provided to be elected by their charter, may elect an adjutant with the rank and commission of captain, a surgeon with the rank and commission of major, an assistant surgeon, a commissary, a paymaster, an inspector of rifle practice, each with the rank and commission of first lieutenant, and an assistant paymaster with rank and commission of second lieutenant.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage, and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
