

ties it would have had or been subject to had not its name been changed as aforesaid, and said corporation is hereby authorized to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT FURTHER TO ENLARGE THE POWERS OF THE CHARITABLE BAPTIST SOCIETY, IN PROVIDENCE."

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section third of "An act further to enlarge the powers of the Charitable Baptist Society, in Providence," passed by the general assembly at its session in January, A. D. 1832, is hereby repealed. All persons who shall be members of said society at the time of the passage of this act shall remain members thereof notwithstanding the repeal of said section third, and said society, at any of their meetings, may elect such persons as they shall think proper to become members of the same.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
