

Section 1. Central Parking Realty Company, a corporation organizing and existing under the laws of the state of Rhode Island and doing business in the city of Providence, is hereby authorized and empowered, with the consent of and upon such terms and conditions as may be described by the city council of said city of Providence, to build and maintain the floors of a garage of one or more floors over the sidewalks located on the easterly side of Pine street, the southerly side of Garnet street, the westerly side of Friendship street and the northerly side of Page street, all of which sidewalks border property now or hereafter standing in the name of Central Parking Realty Company for the purpose of increasing the parking area of all floors above the ground floor of a proposed garage to be erected on land of said Central Parking Realty Company located in said city; provided that every part of said floors except the posts or supports thereof other than the ground floor shall be at least eight (8) feet above the surface of said sidewalks.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

Section 1. That the time of the annual and of the quarterly meetings of said The Charitable Baptist Society, in Providence shall be fixed by the rules, orders, and by-laws of said corporation.

Sec. 2. So much and such parts of said act of which this act is in amendment, and in so much and in such parts of all acts in amendment thereof as are inconsistent of the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect when there shall have been filed with the secretary of state a certificate attested by the clerk of said corporation and bearing its seal setting forth that a majority of the members present at a meeting of the corporation have by vote signified their acceptance of and consent to the provisions of this act.
