No. 644. Resolution Declaring That There Is Need for a Redevelopment Agency to Function in the City of Providence, in Accordance with the Provisions of Chapter 1802, Public Laws of 1946, Known as the "Community Redevelopment Act."


(Approved December 20, 1946.)

*Whereas*, It is hereby found and declared that there exist in some parts of this City blighted areas which constitute either social or economical liabilities, or both, requiring redevelopment in the interest of the health, safety or general welfare of the people of the parts of the City in which they exist, and of the people of this City generally; and

*Whereas*, Chapter 1802 of the Public Laws, passed at the January Session, A. D. 1946, known as the "Community Redevelopment Act," provides ways and means for the rehabilitation and development of such blighted areas in the City; and

*Whereas*, The City of Providence has a Planning Commission, and a master or general community plan has been adopted by the Planning Commission, and the City has otherwise complied with the "prerequisites" of Article IV of said Act;

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence hereby accepts the provisions of said Chapter 1802, Public Laws of 1946, known as the "Community Redevelopment Act," and declares as required by Section 35 of said Act, that there is need for a Redevelopment Agency to function in the City of Providence, and His Honor the Mayor is requested to appoint five resident electors of the City as members of the Agency, as provided by Sections 37 and 38 of said Act.
