Pursuant to the provisions set forth in R.I.G.L. 7-1.2-1310 and 7-1.2-1414, the Certificate of Incorporation/Authority of the above-named entity will be revoked after 60 days from the date of this notice for failure to file the Annual Report.

R.I.G.L. 7-1.2-1501(e) states that any corporation failing or refusing to file its annual report for any year within thirty (30) days after the time prescribed by law is subject to a penalty fee of \$25.00. Due to the late filing, the fee for the 2022 annual report is now \$75.00.
