Plan of Voluntary Dissolution and Distribution of Assets of Karate Instruction Assistance Initiative, Inc.

The Board of Directors of Karate Instruction Assistance Initiative, Inc., a.k.a. KIAI, has considered the advisability of voluntarily dissolving the corporation and has determined that dissolution is in the best interest of the corporation.

Karate Instruction Assistance Initiative, Inc. is a corporation in the State of Rhode Island, in the County of Washington, organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

- 1. The assets of the corporation are in the form of funds in the amount of \$5,313.68.
- 2. The corporation has no liabilities.
- 3. In accordance with the Article 2. of the corporation's By-Laws, the assets are for the purpose to "Enhance the availability and accessibility of instruction in Karate and related martial arts and fitness programs by providing financial assistance for instruction (scholarships) to those who might otherwise be unable to afford such instruction."

Therefore, the corporation proposes to distribute said assets amongst qualifying students/families in attendance at each of the three (3) participating karate instruction organizations to subsidize one-year of instruction for the benefit of said qualifying students as follows:

- a. Two (2) existing scholarship recipient students enrolled at East Coast Karate, (ECK) in Richmond, RI will receive support to further their karate education in the amount of \$1,200 each for a total distribution to students at ECK of \$2,400.
- b. One (1) qualifying student enrolled at Ichiban Karate in Wakefield, RI will receive financial support in the amount of \$1,200.
- c. One (1) qualifying student enrolled at Innovate Karate in North Kingstown, RI will receive financial support in the amount of \$1,200.
- d. The remaining funds in the amount of \$513.68 will be dispersed in the form of four (4) gift certificates to Century Martial Arts Supply company in the amount of \$128.42, one

(1) for each student named above, for the express use of purchasing supplies in support of their karate education.

The above distribution of funds will be carried out before the end of 2022 or within Sixty (60) days of the filing of the necessary dissolution documentation with the State of Rhode Island, Department of State – Business Services Division.
