

### **DEFAULT JUDGMENT**

Judgment by default hereby enters in favor of Plaintiff, Charles A. Pisaturo, Jr., in his capacity as Chapter 7 trustee for Debtor Ernest P. Ricci (the "Plaintiff") and against Defendants Ernest P. Ricci, Brenda P. Ricci and Premier Home Restoration, LLC due to their respective failures to plead or otherwise defend against the Plaintiff's Complaint dated April 18, 2019, as follows:

- i. Judgment is entered against Defendants, jointly and severally, under Count I, declaring that all ownership interests and rights in Defendant Premier Home Restoration, LLC ("Premier") and all of its assets, including (without limitation) Premier's real property, bank deposits, cash, and the rights to all present and future cash distributions, constitute property of the Debtor's bankruptcy estate under 11 U.S.C. § 541 and that Plaintiff, in his capacity as Chapter 7 Trustee is, therefore, the requitable owner of Premier and of all of its assets; AND
- ii. Judgment is entered against Defendant, Ernest P. Ricci, under Count I, declaring that the Plaintiff is entitled to all assets arising from Ernest P. Ricci's rights and interests in the assets of Premier Home Restoration, LLC, including without limitation, the right to all cash and present and future cash distributions, and therefore declaring said assets and distributions as being part of the bankruptcy estate; AND

iii. Judgment is entered for the Plaintiff against the Defendants, jointly and severally, under

Count II, in an amount equal to all of the rental income fraudulently transferred to the Defendants by

Defendants, Brenda Ricci and/or Premier, within four years of the Defendant Ernest Ricci's

bankruptcy filing (under 11 U.S.C. §§ 548, 550, R.I. Gen. Laws § 6-16-1 et seq.,) from the real

property located at 3710 NE 29th Avenue, Pompano Beach, Florida and from the real property

located at 5 Autumn Lane, Bartlett, New Hampshire in an amount to be determined by further order

of this Court: AND

iv. Judgment is entered for the Plaintiff against the Defendants, jointly and severally, under

Count III, avoiding the transfer of the rental income and authorizing the Plaintiff to recover the value

of the transfer of rental income from the Defendants in an amount to be determined by further order

of this Court: AND

v. Judgment is entered for the Plaintiff against the Defendants, jointly and severally under

Count IV determining that Premier Home Restoration, LLC is the alter ego of Ernest P. Ricci.
