ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned acting as incorporator (s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-1.1 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is B.E.T. SALON & SUPPLY, INC.

SECOND: The period of its duration is (if perpetual, so state) perpetual

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- a) Operation and management of a beauty salon and the purchase and sale of beauty supplies.
- b) Any other lawful purposes.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is:

The corporation shall have the option, in case any stockholder desires to sell his stock, to purchase said stock at the lowest price which said stockholder is willing to sell the same before such stock may be sold to any other party. Any stockholder, before making sale of any of his stock, shall give the corporation thirty (30) days' notice in writing, indicating the amount of stock he intends to sell. Such notice shall be sent by certified mail to the corporation at its principal office. At any time within thirty (30) days after receipt of such notice, the corporation shall have the right to purchase said stock and if the corporation shall not accept said offer, then said stockholder may sell his stock so offered to the corporation, to any other party, but in no event at a price below that offered to the corporation.


