ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

(BUSINESS CORPORATION.)

Know all Men by these Presents, That we

John B. Duman
Edward Sturtevant
William Binney

all of lawful age hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 176 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of *St. George's School*

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of engaging in the business of

establishing and maintaining a school for the general education of boys and young men and their preparation for college

4th. Said corporation shall be located in *the Town of Middletown*

in the State of Rhode Island

5th. The capital stock of said corporation shall be common stock in the amount of

Twenty thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of the par value of *one* hundred (\$100.) dollars each.

6th In case of the sale of any shares
of the Capital Stock of said Corporation
by any stockholder therein,
said Corporation shall have
~~the right at any time to pur-~~
~~chase said stock at the~~
lowest price at which he is
willing to sell the same, pro-
vided said Corporation shall
exercise said right within
five days after the receipt
of written notice from such
stockholder of the actual price
offered him for said stock.
