

Attachment to Item 3. The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized:

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, as defined in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, but not limited to the purposes previously set forth in these Articles.

The corporation will not engage in political or lobbying activities beyond what is allowed for a 501(c)(3).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 3.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributions of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
