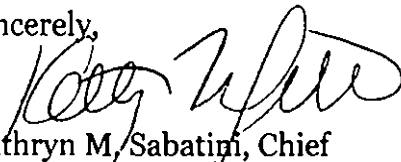
The Office of the Attorney General has received your request to waive or reduce The First Church of Karen Ka, LLC's late fees for a delay in submitting its 2022-2024 annual reports. The reason stated for your request is that you were unaware of the annual report filing requirement.

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 7-1-23, the Attorney General may "compromise" on any penalty and permit the payment of a "smaller sum" than what has been assessed. There is, however, no provision for complete waiver of fees.

After reviewing the information that you provided to this Office and having found no consumer complaints or lawsuits against this company, this letter is to inform you that the Attorney General authorizes a reduction from \$75.00 to \$7.50. This is contingent, however, on the entity submitting the 2022-2024 annual reports to the Secretary of State and paying the filing fees.

You must provide a copy of this letter to the Secretary of State in order to reduce penalty fees. If you have any questions, please contact this Office.
