

TO VACATE THE FORFEITURE OR REVOCATION OF THE CHARTER OF LITTLE COMPTON SCOUT ASSOCIATION, INC.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

١ SECTION 1. The time within which Little Compton Scout Association, Inc. incorporated 2 on December 13, 1965, shall file the reports for the years 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 3 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 4 2024, and 2025, as required under the provisions of Chapter 6 of Title 7 of the General Laws, 1956, 5 is hereby extended to the 31st day of December, A.D., 2025, if said corporation shall file in the 6 office of the secretary of state before December 31, 2025, the reports which it should have filed in 7 the said years and shall pay to the secretary of state the filing fees therefor, having previously thereto paid to the general treasurer for the use of the state such sum as the attorney general shall 8 9 decide should be paid by said corporation as a compromise for the penalty or penalties for its failure 10 to file such reports then the forfeiture or revocation of the charter of said corporation shall 11 thereupon, to wit, upon the filing of said reports and the payment of said fees, be vacated and said corporation shall thereupon be entitled to all of the privileges, benefits and powers and subject to 12 the same duties and liabilities as though no forfeiture or revocation of its said charter had taken 13 14 place.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

Dear Mr. Cady:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request to waive or reduce Little Compton Scout Association, Inc.'s late fee for a delay in submitting its 2002-2025 annual reports. The reason stated for your request is that members are on a volunteer basis and as members have left the association over the years, new volunteer members were not aware of the annual report filing requirement.

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 7-1-23, the Attorney General may "compromise" any penalty and permit the payment of a "smaller sum" than what has been assessed. There is, however, no provision for complete waiver of fees.

After reviewing the information that you provided to this Office and having found no consumer complaints or lawsuits against this company, this letter is to inform you that the Attorney General authorizes a reduction from \$575.00 to \$57.50. This is contingent, however, on the entity submitting the 2002-2025 annual reports to the Secretary of State and paying the filing fees.

You must provide a copy of this letter to the Secretary of State in order to reduce penalty fees. If you have any questions, please contact this Office.
