AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE RHODE ISLAND BOY SCOUTS TO TAKE, HOLD, TRANSMIT AND CONVEY REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE TO AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING ONE MILLION DOLLARS.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. The Rhode Island Boy Scouts, a corporation created April 13, A. D. 1911, under the provisions of chapter 212 of the general laws of Rhode Island and authorized to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all \$150,000.00 under the provision of section 75 of chapter 1925 of the public laws of Rhode Island, entitled "An act in relation to corporations," passed at the January session, A. D. 1920, is hereby authorized and empowered to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all \$1,000,000.00.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage, and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE CERTAIN PERSONS BY THE NAME OF ST. MARK'S CHURCH SOCIETY, IN WARREN," PASSED AT THE JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 1829, AND ALL ACTS IN AMENDMENT THEREOF AND IN ADDITION THERETO.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. The act, entitled "An act to incorporate certain persons by the name of St. Mark's Church Society, in Warren," passed at the January session, A. D. 1829, as amended by acts passed at the May session, A. D. 1855 and at the January session, A. D. 1887, is hereby further amended so as to authorize the St. Mark's Church Society in the town of Warren to

take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. Section 2 of said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“SEC. 2. There shall be a meeting of the society aforesaid on the fourth Monday in January, yearly, forever, for the purpose of regulating their business, electing wardens, vestry, secretary and treasurer; and the wardens of the society be and they are hereby authorized to convene the parishioners of St. Mark's Church Society, at any time and place in Warren when they may judge it advantageous to the interests of the society.”

SEC. 3. Section 3 of said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“SEC. 3. The persons serving as wardens and members of the vestry at the time of the passage of this amendment shall be continued in office until the fourth Monday in January, 1922, or until their successors are elected.”

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage, and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
