ORDER APPOINTING TEMPORARY RECEIVER

This cause came on to be heard before Justice Michael A. Silverstein on November 18, 201,3 upon Petitioner's Petition for the Appointment of a Temporary Receiver and, upon consideration thereof, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED

1. That Mack Russ of ProvRL, be and hereby is appointed Temporary Receiver of 25 John A. Cummings Way, LLC (the "Receiver").

2. That said Receiver shall forthwith file a bond in the sum of \$\frac{10.000}{\text{company}}\$ with any surety company authorized to do business in the State of Rhode Island as surety thereon, conditioned that he/she will well and truly perform the duties of his/her office and duly account for all monies and property which may come into his hands and abide by and perform all things which he/she will be directed to do by this Court.

- 3. That after filing said bond said Receiver is authorized to take possession and charge of the property and assets of the Respondent limited liability company, to collect the debts and property belonging to it and to preserve the same until further Order of this Court.
- 4. That said Receiver is authorized until further Order of this Court, in his/her discretion and as he/she deems appropriate and advisable, to conduct the business of said Respondent corporation; borrow money from time to time; purchase, for cash or upon credit, merchandise, materials and other property; to engage employees and assistants, clerical or otherwise; and to do and perform, or cause to be done and performed, all other acts and things as are appropriate in the premises.
- 5. That, other than as excepted below, the commencement, prosecution or continuance of the prosecution of any actions, suit, arbitration proceeding, hearing or any foreclosure, reclamation or repossession proceeding, whether judicial or non-judicial, or any other proceeding, in law or in equity, under any statute or otherwise, against said Respondent limited liability company or any of its property, in any court, agency, tribunal or elsewhere, or before any arbitrator, or otherwise, by any creditor, stockholder, corporation, partnership or any other person, or the levy of any attachment, execution or other process upon or against any property of said Respondent limited liability company, or the taking or attempting to take into possession any property in the possession of the Respondent limited liability company or of which the Respondent limited liability company has the right to possession, by any of such parties as aforesaid, other than the Receiver designated as aforesaid, or the termination of telephone, electric, gas or any other utility service to Respondent limited liability company, by any public utility,

without obtaining approval thereof from this Honorable Court, in which connection said Receiver shall be entitled to prior notice and an opportunity to be heard, are hereby restrained and enjoined until further Order of this Court. Notwithstanding the language above to the contrary, the Receiver shall not take any action that impedes or interferes with any foreclosure or foreclosure sale process implemented by the Petitioner, or its assignee, in carrying out the duties contained in this Order, and Petitioner, or its assignee, shall have the right, at its option and without the requirement of any approval of this Court, to foreclose the mortgage upon the Property and that secures the Note and to otherwise realize upon the security for the Note during the pendency of the Receivership (all as defined in the Petitioner's Petition"). Nothing in this Order is intended to reduce, enhance, or otherwise modify any rights held by the Petitioner or the Respondent in and to the Property.
