WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of East Providence did on the 19th day of December, 1961, conduct a public hearing, notice of which appeared in the Providence Journal on December 7, 1961, on a petition of Gordon A. Taylor and at least 84 other residents of the City of East Providence on the necessity for the establishment of a Housing Authority, in accordance with the laws of Rhode Island; and

WHEREAS, The City Council did on December 19, 1961 adopt a resolution that there is a necessity for the appointment of a Housing Authority for the City of East Providence and that a Housing Authority be appointed; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor of the City of East Providence, Daniel E. Marso, did on December 19, 1961, appoint the following as members of the East Providence Housing Authority for the terms commencing on the third Tuesday in December, 1961:

WHEREAS, The said Commissioners were on January 2, 1962, inducted into office and received their oaths of engagement; and that they desire to become a public body and a body corporate and politic under Section 45-25-7 of the General Laws of Rhode Island 1956, as amended, and

WHEREAS, The several Commissioners have been appointed to the Housing Authority for one, two, three, four, and five year terms commencing on the third Tuesday in December, 1961, as follows:


RESOLUTION NO. 18

RESOLUTION CREATING THE EAST PROVIDENCE HOUSING AUTHORITY

- WHEREAS, The City Council of East Providence did on December 19, 1961 conduct a public hearing on the necessity for a Housing Authority to function in East Providence; and
- WHEREAS, Testimony was presented that there exists within the City many superannuated dwellings which by their unsafe and unsanitary condition endanger life and property by fire and other causes; and
- WHEREAS, Further evidence was presented that cited conditions of overcrowding and excessive land coverage cause a lack of proper light, air, and space; and
- WHEREAS, Many persons of low income are forced to reside in these unsafe buildings; and
- WHEREAS, These conditions cause an increase in the spread of disease and crime, and constitute a menace to the health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of the City; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of East Providence, by the evidence and testimony received, determines that there exists a need for a Housing Authority to function in the City; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Mayor of the City be given notice of such determination that he may appoint commissioners to act as an authority in accordance with the laws of the State of Rhode Island.
