

APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

To: J. Hector Paquin,
Secretary of State,
State of Rhode Island.

We, the undersigned Commissioners of The Housing Authority of the City of Pawtucket, Rhode Island, hereby apply, in pursuance of the provisions of The Housing Authorities Law, Chapter 2255, Public Laws of Rhode Island, 1935, for a certificate incorporating said Housing Authority, and in support of such application furnish the following information:

1. On the 9th day of June, 1939, appropriate notice of a public hearing, in connection with the need for a Housing Authority to function in the City of Pawtucket, Rhode Island, was given by legal notice published in the Pawtucket Times. The public hearing was duly held on the 21st day of June, 1939, and following the hearing, the Council determined, in accordance with the provisions of Section 4 of the aforementioned Chapter 2255, that there was need for an Authority in the City of Pawtucket, Rhode Island. Immediately following this determination, the Mayor appointed the five Commissioners of The Authority. Appended to this application is a certified copy of the Mayor's certificate of appointment;

2. The name and official residence of each of the Commissioners, as well as the date and place of the induction into and the taking oath of office, are as follows:

CERTIFICATE RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT
OF MEMBERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF
THE CITY OF PAWTUCKET, RHODE ISLAND,
AND THE DESIGNATION OF THE FIRST CHAIRMAN.

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of June, 1939, a public hearing was held in accordance with the applicable provisions of The Housing Authorities Law, Chapter 2255, Public Laws of Rhode Island, 1935, for the purpose of allowing the residents and taxpayers of the City of Pawtucket, Rhode Island, and other interested persons to express to the Council their views on the necessity for a Municipal Housing Authority to function in the City; and

WHEREAS, following the afore-mentioned public hearing, the Council of the City of Pawtucket, Rhode Island, met and adopted the following resolution:

"THE CITY OF PAWTUCKET

- - - - -

JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved June 21, 1939.

"WHEREAS, twenty-five residents of the City filed, in accordance with the authority vested in them by Chapter 2255 of the Public Laws enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island at the May session, A. D. 1935, a petition dated June 8, 1939, with the City Clerk, in which they set forth their opinion that there is need for a Housing Authority to function in this City; and

"WHEREAS, at a public hearing duly held by the Council on this day a number of residents and taxpayers of the City, as well as other interested persons, indicated that in their opinion a Municipal Housing Authority should be established,

"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAWTUCKET, RHODE ISLAND:

"That the City Council of the City of Pawtucket, Rhode Island, after having given due consideration to the physical condition and the age of certain buildings in the City, the degree of overcrowding, the light and air available to the

inhabitants of such dwelling accommodations, the size and arrangement of the rooms, the sanitary facilities, and the extent to which conditions exist in such dwellings which endanger life or property by fire or other causes, hereby determines, finds and declares in pursuance of the provisions of the Housing Authorities Law of the State of Rhode Island:

- "A. Unsanitary or unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist in this City; and
- "B. There is a lack of safe and sanitary dwelling accommodations in this City available for all inhabitants thereof.
- "C. There is need for a Housing Authority in this City.

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately."

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provision of said resolution, in pursuance of Sections 4 and 5, Chapter 2255, Public Laws of Rhode Island, 1935, and by virtue of my office as Mayor:

I hereby appoint the five persons hereinafter named to serve as Commissioners of The Housing Authority of the City of Pawtucket, Rhode Island, for the number of years appearing after their names respectively:

- William L. Connolly- - - - -Five Years.
- Frank Crook- - - - -Four Years.
- Joseph Charpentier- - - - -Three Years.
- Edmond C. Laurelli - - - - -Two Years.
- Edward J. Costello - - - - -One Year.

The terms of office of the Commissioners shall begin as of the date of this Certificate. The Commissioners shall hold office until their successors have been appointed and have duly qualified.

I hereby designate William L. Connolly to serve as the first Chairman of the Housing Authority until his successor, elected from among the members of the Authority, shall have duly qualified.
