THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of Operating a credit union in accordance with Title 19, Chapter 21 General
Laws 1956.
In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and authority, viz:—(See §§ *********************************
in all one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000); provided, however, that the foregoing limitation shall not apply to corporations organized for the purposes of fostering, encouraging and assisting the physical location, settlement or resettlement of industrial and manufacturing enterprises within the state, and to whose members no profit shall source. If any corporation subject to the foregoing limitation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto

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FOURTH. Said corporation shall be located in Providence, Rhode Island.
