ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

(BUSINESS CORPORATION.)

Know all Men by these Presents, That we

Demis Affleckson and John C. Lyons, of the City and County of Providence in the State of Rhode Island and James F. Morris, Bernard A. Doherty and Nathaniel W. Earle, of Fall River in the County of Bristol and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, all of lawful age hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 176 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of the Mount Hope Ferry Company

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of engaging in the business of a common carrier of passengers and goods and merchandise by means of boats propelled by steam or other motive power

4th. Said corporation shall be located in the City of Providence

5th. The capital stock of said corporation shall be common stock in the amount of Fifty thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of the par value of One Hundred dollars each.
