ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION.

(BUSINESS CORPORATION.)

Know all Men by these Presents, That we *Robert Barland, of the City of Providence, William E. White of the City of Pawtucket and Lowell J. P. Lake of the Town of Cranston, all in the County of Providence in said State;*

all of lawful age hereby agree to and with each other:

1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 176 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of

*Providence, Newport and Block Island
Transportation Company.*

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of engaging in the business of *owning, leasing, operating and disposing of real and personal property, vessels and boats, and operating a steamboat line between Providence, Newport, and Block Island, and such other places as may be said corporation be determined; and the transaction of all business incidental thereto, and connected therewith.*

4th. Said corporation shall be located in

the said City and County of Providence.

5th. The capital stock of said corporation shall be common stock in the amount of

Twenty-five thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of the par value of
Five dollars each.

6th. No stockholder shall sell his stock, without first offering it to the Corporation at the lowest cash price which he is willing to accept for the same, and he shall give to the Corporation an option of ten days in which to accept or refuse his said offer.
